Celebrating 5 years of ministry in Lincoln!

In August, we marked five years of ministry in Lincoln by hosting our first-ever Atlas: Lincoln Anniversary Celebration! Over 75 amazing folks showed up to recognize the night with us. We enjoyed a beautiful venue at the Gala, an excellent meal from Lulu's, and shared some stories from

the last five years through our 5-Year Report, which you can find on our website.

We shared about presence and faithfulness to the individuals in front of us, the charge to love our neighbors who feel that they're worthless, and the call to walk with hurting people like Jesus.

When I think about the last five years, there are plenty of stories people would label successes. There are also plenty of stories that people might label failures.

There are folks we've walked with who have worked to overcome their lifealtering difficulties. They've maintained sobriety. They've started businesses. They've found safe, supportive housing they love. They've connected with a healthy community, new friends, or a church home. They have grown immensely and continue that trajectory even today. There are folks we've walked with for years who don't seem to be any further along than when we started walking with them. Some are now incarcerated and will be for many years. There have been neighbors living on the streets that we've walked with for half a decade and remain on the streets. There are some who have relapsed and cut contact with Atlas and

Striving to Love our Neighbors Well

We have operated out of our current office space for over two years. Last summer, we took over the upstairs space, effectively doubling the usable space available to us. In moving into the neighborhood and taking over the additional space, we continually prayed and discerned how best we could love our neighbors well.

Last summer, we partnered with Fellowship Community Church to be a once-a-month lunch ministry in the neighborhood. Our staff and volunteers from the church went out in groups of two and three people to meet our neighbors on their turf, provide a free lunch, and share in conversation and connection.

This ministry has grown exponentially in 2023. We partnered with a local business group and with our friends at Lulu's to fill other weeks of the month. With the help of many volunteers from the business group, the church, and Deck City, our staff, board, and so many others, we are

sending folks into the neighborhood with meals, conversation, presence, and love.

At the end of August, many states were impacted by one of the worst heatwaves in recent history. Thanks to the David Staenberg Family Foundation, we were able to provide free water to our neighborhood for the week and we gave away over 400 bottles of cold water.


Finally, in September, we hosted our annual Open-House event and provided food to 200 people from the neighborhood and beyond.
