


**Fiscal year through February – grateful to our supporters**

The community of Lincoln joins together in an amazing show of generosity and investment throughout the month of May. In its eleventh year, “Give to Lincoln Day” on May 26, 2022 provides an opportunity for people to support the non-profits of our great city.
