In January, some of our staff traveled to northwest lowa to meet with other ATLAS staffs for training and fellowship.

February brought our 5th Annual Trivia Night Fundraiser. A great group of people showed up for fun, fellowship, and raising

funds to support the ministry of Atlas in Lincoln. We want to thank everyone who attended the event, Trinity Lutheran for hosting us again this year, and Jess Hustad, BancWise Realty for her sponsorship in support of the night.

At the beginning of March, we hosted our annual Donor Appreciation Dinner. In addition to honoring 2022 donors, we also celebrated 5 mentor-mentee pairings that had reached the milestone of meeting together for one year! These amazing folks received a token commemorating their accomplishment and exchanged personal letters expressing what they meant to one another.

We are also currently on track for meeting our 2023 goal of 36 mentormentee pairings, a 30% increase from last year. These relationships continue to grow and support one another, walking together in an intentional and encouraging Christ-based relationship.



"Give to Lincoln Day" 2023


